The Washington Draft Horse & Mule Association is pleased to announce the availability of the PATRICIA HAGLIN SCHOLARSHIP application for 2018. **Deadline for submission of applications and required documents is February 28, 2018.**

The Patricia Haglin Scholarship fund was set up in 1993 to promote agricultural education in Washington State and to promote draft horses and mules to the young people who are our future audience and exhibitors.

All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply. This year a \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified Washington state resident. Applicants must have a 3.0 grade point average. Both high school seniors and continuing college students may apply.

Eligible students will have a minimum 3.0 grade point average, and be enrolled at or accepted by, any accredited college or vocational school. Preference is given to students in agricultural majors. Previous scholarship winners have pursued fields such as Agricultural Marketing, Dairy Management, Food Science, Agricultural Management, Food Packaging, Horticulture, Animal Science, Veterinary Science, Forestry/Land Management, etc.
